Additional funding proposals shared. Increase # of people have been calling wanting to quit! SB150, the Statewide SF air Bill , is still in committee and Senator Breske & Sen. Risser are supposed to come to an agreement- NOT Happening. MN is sf statewide as of 10/01/07 and IL will be 100% sf Jan. 1,2008, MI passed through house of representatives. Gov. Doyle is voicing WI not to become to the ashtray of the Midwest.
