<p>Welcome &amp; Treasury Report</p> <p>Old /New Business</p>	<p>Tom Mathea &amp; Bill Vancos, co-chairs welcomed members. Short history of coalition discussed and role of CTRI (Center of Tobacco Research &amp; Intervention). Laura reported budget of \$1,400.81. Separate budgets running for General Funds, RHS FACT, JWMS FACT &amp; HPHOC. January minutes reviewed and motion to accept put forward by Tom Mathea and Jackie Cody – approved.</p> <p><b>OLD BUSINESS/NEW BUSINESS</b></p> <p><b>State Action</b> – SB 150 passed out of the Senate Public Health Committee but is being stalled by Senator Decker and Breske at state senate. Negotiations from Breske, Decker, and Tavern League include: 2011 implementation for bars including restaurants with liquor license, and pre-emption - not allowing communities to pass local policies. NOT ACCEPTABLE. Rally being planned for March 4<sup>th</sup> at state capitol.</p> <p><b>Local Action</b> – Media coverage from the last month circulated. Discussion re: 2 new smoke free businesses in Minocqua, The VINE and The Concord Inn. “Don’t Let WI become the Ashtray of the Midwest” posters circulated throughout community. Bill Vancos Reported Foster &amp; Smith have sf policy inside, but do have a smoking hut on grounds. Colleen reported Oldenburg does not have a policy and is working on this at corporate level.</p> <p>Coalition Building - Jackie Cody submitted coalition meeting schedule to print, websites, and cable. Jessica Buss considering working on newsletter twice a year. RHS FACT designed display window for Associated Bank promoting tfocc.net and FACT, up until end of Feb. **Tobacco Treatment**

Susanne reported working with Ministry peds department re: fax to quit. Linda Seiter interested in implementing for Riverside. Angie with Trig's was contacted and offered follow up regarding treatment coverage and availability of resources for employees. Susanne reported being at emergency at seeing Phillip Morris material in exam room, discussion to contact hospital. New Quit Line brochures shared, 2 levels of reading available. Linda Seiter requested treatment resources for clinic. Discussion also centered on looking at question on patient forms that addresses tobacco use. Want to be sure patients are being asked about tobacco, not just smoking.

**Influence Grant - Women of Influence** – TFOCC received the \$1,000.00 grant to implement a black and white event - Women's Night Out of "Influence" Laura contacted Marshfield Clinic, Amber Weldon, and Ministry, Tracy J. re: partnering. Heather Shallock will emcee, Stacy Hammes from HYHC will be a speaker, tentatively set for the evening of May 12<sup>th</sup>. Tom checked on the Top of the Pointe and available. Nicolet approached for catering. Merrill held one week before, very successful. Laura has material to use.

**Other-** Approached RHS schools about having Gruen Von Behrens come and speak.
